Employment of Project Affected Persons -Grant of concessions for the Purpose of -

READ: Government Resolution, Revenue and Forests Department, No. RPA-1071/1777785/R-1, dated the 20th November 1973.

Persons, Government has issued orders of giving highest priority for employment in the Irrigation Project Establishment to the Project Affected Persons and their dependents. In practice, how ver, it is observed that this has not helped them to any appreciable extend. The question of giving the Project Affected Persons and their dependents further concessions to overcome the difficulties experienced by them in securing employment under Government was under consideration. Government is pleased to accord the following concessions to the Project Affected Persons and their dependents in regard to employment to posts in Government offices situated outside Greater Bombay.

- (1) In respect of those project affected persons whose houses are sub-marged under the project, or who lose 75% of their land for the project, the upper age limit for entry into Government service should be relaxed by 3 years.
- (2) The period spent by a Project Affected Persons who fulfils the condition laid down in para l(l), in temporary service under Government should be computed for calculating the upper age limit and the same should be further relaxed by the quantum of this period. When the Project Affected Person gets re-employed in another job, the time spent by him on temporary job with Government earlier should be counted for his subsequent service and the entire service should be treated as one without break.
- 2. The concessions mentioned in para 1 above are admissible to those Project Affected Persons who produce a certificate in the prescribed form issued by the Resettlement Officer concerned a behalf of the Collector as provided in Government Circular, we need Administration Department, No. APA-1569-R-1, dated the 14th January 1971.
- 3. In making appointments to Class-III and IV posts the appointing authorities should take into consideration the above concessions and give preference to these persons if they fulfil the other conditions of the relevant recruitment rules.
- 4. These orders will apply to recruitment to posts and services which are outside the purview of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission.
