## CIRCULAR

The attention of all Heads of Departments is invited to Government Circular, General Administration Department, No. SRV-1075-X, dated the 2nd January 1976. As intimated therein, Government desires that the benefits of a substantive status in service, sanctioned by Government Resolution, General Administration Department, No. SRV-1075-X, dated the 19th deptember 1975, should become actually available without avoidable delay to every Government servant who is eligible for them. All Heads of Departments were accordingly requested to see that the cases of all Government servants under their control are examined quickly, and that the requisite certificates are promptly recorded in favour of all who are eligible for them.

2. Government now desires that, in the case of all Government servants who, as on 1st April 1976, are eligible for these benefits, the requisite certificates should be recorded on or before 31st May 1976. All Heads of Departments are, therefore, requested to ensure that the cases of all Government servants under their control are examined expeditiously, and that the necessary certificates are recorded not later than 31st May 1976 in favour of all who, as on 1st April 1976, were eligible for them. A compliance report should be sent to this Department by 15th 1976, under intimation to the respective administrative Department of the Secretariat.
