ORDER OF GOVERNMENT

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Bombay Village Panchayats Act, 1958 (Bom. III of 1959) and in supersession of the orders contained in the former Government of Bombay Resolution in the Local Self-Government and Public Health Department, No. VPA.1150-V, dated the 6th June, 1959, the Government of Maharashtra hereby directs that a village having a population indicated in column (1) of the Table shall have the number of members specified against it in column (2) thereof:

T A B L E	
Population of a Village.	Number of members.
(1)	(2)
(a) A village with a population of 1,000 or less	7 members.
(b) A village with a population of more than, 1,000 but not more than 2,000	9 members.
(c) A village with a population of more than 2,000 but not more than 3,000	11 members.
(d) A village with a population of more than 3,000 but not more than 4,000	13 members.
(e) A village with a population of more than 4,000	15 members.

Provided that, the number of members specified in clauses (a), (b), (c) and (d) of the Table may be increased by one, if necessary to satisfy the requirements of rules 3 and 4 of the Bombay Village Panchayats (Division of Village into Wards and Reservation of Seats for Women, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Rules, 1966.

Explanation:- In this Order "population" in relation to a village means the population of that village as ascertained at the last preceding census of which the relevant figures have been published.
