In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders and instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Circle Inspector (Class III) in the Revenue Department :

1. (i) These rules may be called the Maharashtra Revenue Department Circle Inspector (Recruitment) Rules, 1936.

(ii) They shall come into force with effect from

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise :

a) "Circle Inspector" includes Revenue Inspector;

b) "Clerk" means the holder of the post of Clerk in Konkan Division, Washik Division, Pune Division, Aurangabad Division and Junior Clerk in Nagpur Division and Amravati Division;

c) "Collector" means the Collector of a district appointed under section 7 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1960.

d) "Qualified persons" means a person who has passed or who has been exempted from passing the S.S.P. Examination prescribed for talathis.

e) "Talathi" means a person holding a post of Talathi Patwari.

3. Appointment to the post of Circle Inspector shall be made by promotion on the basis of seniority subject to fitness, from amongst the qualified persons holding the post of Talathi.

Provided that with a view to imparting training to the clerks in executive duties, temporary appointment to the post of Circle Inspector may be made by promotion of Clerks for a period not exceeding 3 years in each case.

Provided further that the posts filled in by promotion of Clerks shall not exceed 25 per cent of the total number of posts in the cadre from time to time.

4. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass the departmental examination and examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing, those examinations.

5. The Cadre of Circle Inspector shall be a district cadre and the persons from this cadre shall be transferable anywhere in the district.

6. The Collector shall be the appointing authority in respect of the cadre of Circle Inspector in each district.
