RESOLUTION: Under the revised minimum needs programme for rural
health Services incorporated in the sixth Five Year Plan
(1980-1985) establishment of sub-centres on the basis of one
for every 5000 population has been indicated, which coverage
should be achieved by 1988. Sub-Centres from the gross roots
in the delivery of comprehensive health care to the needy
rural and Tribal community. At present, criteria of one
Sub-Centre for 10,000 population has been fulfilled. As per the
directives of the Government of India it is first proposed to
have one Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (Sub-Centre) for every 8000
population for which assistance from the Government of India
is admissible. In order to fulfill the target of having one
sub-centre for every 8000 population, the requirements for
sub-centres is 505. This target is proposed to be achieved
in a phased manner as follows :-

2. Sanction is therefore accorded to the creation of
150 posts of Auxiliary Nurse Midwives in the pay scale of
Rs. 290-10-390-Extn-15-340 + allowances (Dearness allowance, H.
Uniform Allowance & washing allowance) as admissible and
150 posts of Attendants on a fixed pay of Rs. 50/- p.m. as shown
in the accompanying statement.

3. Since this is a centrally assisted scheme 50% of the
requirement under Pay and allowance only of the A.N.M. will
be received from the Government of India. During the year
1980-81 the financial requirements for 150 sub-centres will
be as follows :-
