CIRCULAR : It has come to the notice of Government that the decisions on appeals submitted to District/Divisional authorities under the provisions of Bombay Village Panchayats Act 1958, are communicated to the applicants by ordinary post. This practice gives room to the parties concerned to say that the orders were received by them late and hence further appeal to higher authorities could not be submitted within the stipulated time limit.

Government is therefore pleased to direct that, whenever any order on an appeal under the provisions of the Bombay Village Panchayats Act, 1958, is to be communicated to the party concerned officially, it should be communicated to him by registered post acknowledgement due, unless the party is in the head quarters and could be contacted personally. The date of receipt of the communications by the party should always be carefully noted.

In cases where the communications in question are delivered to the parties by hand delivery, it should be insisted that the parties should particularly mention the date of receipt of the communications by them in the delivery book.
