CIRCULAR.


In Government L-etter, Revenue and Forests Department, No. LNA-1069-35604-(b)-C, dated 10th September 1969 and Government Circular, Revenue Department, No. LNA-1071-C-II, dated 13th September 1971, instructions have been issued to all Collectors that with a view to disposing of applications for Non-Agricultural-Permission under Section 44 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1966 expeditiously and within the statutory period of 90 days, the Collector should convene meetings of the officers of Town Planning Department, Buildings and Communications Department the concerned Municipalities and other concerned Departments every month for considering such applications received by them. Government is further pleased to direct that as soon as an application for Non-Agricultural Permission for industrial purposes is received in the case of private lands, The Collector should write simultaneously to the Town Planning Department, Building and Communications Department, the concerned Municipal Corporation/ Municipal Council and to other concerned departments from whom " No Objection Certificate " or clearance is required, they may also be informed that their remarks should be communicated to the Collector within a period of 1 month from the date of

receipt of the communication from the Collector and that if their remarks are not received within this time limit, it would be presumed that they have no objection in the matter. The application for grant of Non-Agricultural-Permission for industrial purposes should be decided accordingly.
