

CIRCULAR OF GOVERNMENT

District Industries Centres have been set up in all the Districts in this State with a view to encouraging and assisting Industrial units those desire to develop in areas other than Metropolitan Cities. The General Managers of the District Industries Centres have been delegated administrative, financial and operational powers with a view to expediting the cases of Industrial units. The power to grant Non-agricultural Permission, however, is vested in Collectors of Districts and in carrying out this function, the Collectors consult field Officers of Town Planning and Valuation Department within whose jurisdiction the cases fall. Since one of the objectives of setting up of District Industries Centres in all the Districts of the State and in delegating various powers to the General Managers of such District Industries Centres is to expedite the cases of Industrial units desiring to start Industries in areas, other than Metropolitan Cities, it follows that the Non-agricultural Permissions should be granted expeditiously in such cases. Government is, therefore, pleased to stress the need of disposing of all such cases received by the Officers of Town Planning and Valuation Department, as expeditiously as possible with a view to achieving the objective mentioned above. All the Officers of Town Planning and Valuation Department are requested to

ensure that such cases are returned duly scrutinised to the Collectors of the Districts, as far as possible within a period of one week from the date of receipt thereof. Any information required in scrutinising such cases should be obtained by the Officers of Town Planning and Valuation Department by approaching the applicants with the help of District Industries Centres rather than returning the cases on technical grounds. The Collectors are also requested to ensure that entire information that is needed by the Officers of Town Planning and Valuation Department in dealing with Non- agricultural Permission cases is furnished so that there is no occasion for delay in scrutinising such cases.
