RESOLTTON : Under Section 44 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code 1966, application for grant of Mon-Agricultural-Axxxxxxxxx permission is required to be recided by the Collector within a period of 90 days from the date of received of application or from the date of acknowledgement of such If the Collector fails to inform the applicant about his decision within the aforesaid period, permission applied for is deemed to be granted. Government has already prescribed a form of application for grant of Mon-Agricultural-Permission under the Maharashtra Land Revenue (Conversion of use of land and Mon-Agricultural-Assessment) Rules, 1969. After applications in the prescribed forms are received, the Collector has to make enquiry into such applications before granting Mon-Agricultural-Permission. With a view to ensuring that such applications are decided within the prescribed statotory period, Government is pleased to prescribe form prixing the distance and accompany into such application as also the form in which the order granting W.A. Permission should be issued. With a view to achieving uniformity in making enquiries into such applications and issuing orders OFFICE OF THE COLFERTING Mon-Agricultural-Permission, these forms should be

inted as an accompaniment.
