READ: Government Resolution, Environment Department No. ENV 1085/
470/CR-86/Desk-II, dated 23rd December 1985.

RESOLUTION: A State Appraisal Committee for scrutiny of applica-
tions to give environmental clearance for the establishment of
hazardous chemical industries was constituted under Government
Resolution, Environment Department No. ENV-1085/470/CR-86/Desk-II,
dated 23rd December 1985. The question of expanding the scope
of the Committee, with a view to bring within its purview,
industries identified by the Government of India for obtaining
environmental approval for siting was under consideration of
Government for some time. Government is now pleased to direct
that the applications received from the following types of
industries should be considered by the State Appraisal Committee
for giving environmental clearance :-

The industries coming up in the industrial areas of the Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation, City and Industrial Development Corporation, Nagpur Improvement Trust which industrial areas have already been established will not come within the purview of the State Appraisal Committee. Small Scale Industries identified by the Industries Department shall also not come within the purview of the State Appraisal Committee.

3. In addition to the six copies of proforma required to be submitted to the State Appraisal Committee under the Government Resolution of 23rd December 1985, referred to in the preamble, the Committee may decide the procedure to be followed by it, including calling for additional information, or modifying the proforma to suit specific industries, if it is found necessary, to satisfy itself on the site selected by the industry to be suitable from the environmental point of view.

4. Industries falling in the list given in paragraph 1 who have not so far obtained the approval from the environmental point of view will be required to follow the procedure laid down in the Government Resolution, dated 23rd December 1985.
