RESCLUTION: Government had under consideration the question of making available to Village Panchavats cultivable waste lands, which they could bring under cultivation, utilise them in the interest of the Village Community and also augment their resources. Government is pleased to direct, in modification of the Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No.IND.3960/33601-4, dated the 2th February 1961, that cultivable waste lands, not exceeding the maximum area admissible to an individual landless labourer, should be given to Village Panchayats on lease, for a period of 10 years in the first instance, on payment of rent equal to one and a half times the assessment, provided lands are available in the respective villages. The Village Panchayats should as far as possible utilize the lands so leased, as demonstration farms or seed multiplication farms. The income derived from such lands should be utilized for public purposes of Village Panchayats.
