DISTRICT MALARIA OFFICER

Appointment to the post shall be made either -

- (a) by promotion of persons working in the Public Health Department and possessing
 - i) W.B.B.S.degree or any other qualification specified in the First or the Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act. 1956; or
 - tion with not less than five years' service in the Public Health Department; or
 - iii) D.A.S.F. or D.M.P. qualification with not less than seven years' service in the Malaria Organisation as Assistant Unit Officer or Senior Malaria Supervisor; or
 - iv) a degree in Science with not less than seven years' service in the Walaria Organisation as Assistant Unit Officer or Senior Walaria Supervisor;
 - (b) by nomination from among candidates

- i) unless already in the service of the Government of Mahárashtra, are not more than thirty-five years of age; and
- ii) possess a degree in Medicine of a statutory University or any other qualification specified in the First or Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956:

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed in the case of candidates possessing exceptional qualifications and/or experience.

- 2. The selected candidate, if holding a medical qualification, will be required to register himself under the Bombay Medical Act, 1912, before joining the appointment unless he is already so registered.
- 3. A candidate appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- 4. A person whether appointed by promotion or by nomination will be required to pass

an examination in Marathi and an examination in Hindi according to the prescribed rules.
