In exercise of

the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Theatre Assistant, in the Directorate of Health Services, Public Health Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Theatre Assistant Class-III, (in the Directorate of Health Service Recruitment) Rules, 1984.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise, -

a) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Health Services, Maharashtra State;

b) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

c) "Secondary School Certificate Examination" means the Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by a Divisional Board under the Maharashtra Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards Act, 1965 (Mah.XLI of 1965), and include any other examination declared by Government to be equivalent thereto.

3. Appointment to the post of Theatre Assistant in the Directorate shall be made, either :-

a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness, from amongst the persons holding Class-IV; posts for not less than three years in the Directorate and possessing qualification prescribed for appointment by nomination in sub-clause (ii) of clause (b) of this rule; or

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b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,

i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than twenty eight years of age; and

ii) have passed Secondary School Certificate Examination :

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the appointing authority in favour of candidates having exceptional qualification or experience or both :

Provided further that, preference may be given to candidates possessing experience of working or training in a Laboratory. ~~Theater Working Hospital~~

4. Appointment to the posts by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 25:75.

5. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or nomination, shall be required to pass departmental examinations and examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing, those examinations.

6. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules if in the opinion of Government, the exigencies of service so require, Government may permit the appointing authority wherever necessary, to make appointments to the post of Laboratory Assistant in relaxation of the percentages prescribed in these rules for recruitment by nomination.

6. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of one year.
 7. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion/transfer or nomination, shall be required to pass the Departmental Examination and examination in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing, those examinations.
 8. A person appointed to the post shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any defence services of India, anywhere in or outside India for a period of four years, not less than four years (inclusive of the period spent in training, if any) on such conditions as may be determined from time to time by the Government of India.
 9. Provided that such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment and ordinarily after he has attained the age of 45 years.
 10. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer where in the state of Maharashtra.

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
