

Special Conveyance Allowance --Grant of -- to blind and orthopaedically handicapped employees.

GOVERNMENT RESOLUTION.

Under Government Resolution, Finance Department quoted at (1) above, a special conveyance allowance at 10 percent of basic pay subject to a maximum of Rs.50, p.m. has been sanctioned to such Government employees as are blind or are orthopsedically handicapped with disability of lower extremities. The above maximum limit has been raised to Rs.75/- p.m.under Government Resolution, Finance Department quoted at (2) above. On the basis of the recommendations of the Fourth Central Pay Commission, the Central Government has fixed the rate of special convexance allowance, with reference to the revised pay scales, at 5 percent of the basic pay subject to a maximum of Rs.100/- p.m. The question of revising the rate of special conveyance allowance for State Government employees in the context of the revised pay scales was under consideration for some time. Government is please to direct that the rate of special conveyance allowance for the bland and orthopaedically handicapped employees including disability of hands and feetshall, with effect from 1st February 1989, be 5 per cent of the basis pay suvject to a meximum of Rs.100/- p.m. in the revised pay scales, prescribed under Maharashtra Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1988. In the case of employees who opt to draw pay in the prerevised scale, their pay will include, in addition to the basic pay in the prerevised scale, the dearness allowance admissible as on 1st January 1986, amount of two interim reliefs plus ad hoc increase of 20 per cent of basic pay subject to a maximum of Rs.75/-.

Other conditions for grant or special conveyance allowance prescribed under Government Resolution, Finance Department No.TRA-1379/CR SER-5 dated 20th February 1980 will continue to operate.

2. Government is also pleased to direct that for the period prior to 1st February 1989, the rate and the Maximum limit of the special conveyance allowance even after the revision of pay scales shall be as at present i.e. 10 per cent of basic pay subject to a maximum of Rs.75/p.m. and for this purpose, unrevised pay in the pay-scales existing prior to revised pay scales applicable from 1st January 1986 will be taken into consideration.
