CIRCULAR:- By the Government Circular, Finance Department, No.FNR 1072/945/F-1, dated the 23rd October 1972, all Heads of Offices and Heads of Departments were requested to furnish a six monthly report to Government regarding misappropriation cases and the Administrative Departments of the Secretariat were requested to forward a consolidated return to the Accountant General, Maharashtra. Government has now decided that the consolidated returns need not be forwarded to the Accountant General, Maharashtra. But the Administrative Departments should scrutinise the reports received by them and keep a close watch in the completion of proceedings/enquiries in all cases of disciplinary action against the delinquents.
