

Circular

The Comptroller and Auditor General of India has in his Audit Report (Civil) for 1979-80 brought to the notice of the State Government that there is a very large pendency in disposal of misappropriation cases in the State. He has also highlighted the fact that out of the total 507 cases pending finalisation the number of cases pending with the Revenue and Forests Department stands at 283 i.e. about 56 per cent of the total. Out of them over 100 cases are pending for over 5 years and only 40 cases were finalised upto January 1982. The progress of disposal is thus very unsatisfactory and deserves special attention. In a very large number of cases, slow progress in departmental action at several stages and in investigation by the Police Department appears to be the cause for delay. A careful watch and vigorous pursuance in these cases at different stages by the local officers concerned would certainly improve the situation. It is therefore, necessary for all Controlling Officers/Heads of Offices to prescribe a periodical review of all such cases with them or pertaining to them and ensure that there is no delay and that the cases are progressing well and are finalised as quickly as possible.
