Read Government Notification, Local Self-Government and Public Health Department, No. VPA. 1159-P, dated 23rd January 1960.

RESOLUTION.—The objections or suggestions received with reference to Government Notification, Local Self-Government and Public Health Department, No. VPA. 1159-P, dated 23rd January 1960, having been considered, the accompanying Notification should be published in the *Bombay Government Gazette*.

2. The Notification should be forwarded to the Examiner of Books and Publications and the Director, Government Printing and Stationery. The Examiner should be requested to translate the Notification into all the regional languages of the State of Bombay and to forward copies of the translations to the Manager, Government Central Press, who should publish the translations of the Notification in the *Bombay Government Gazette*.

3. The Director, Government Printing and Stationery, should be requested to keep in stock, at the Government Book Depot, sufficient number of copies of Notification in English and in the regional languages of the State for supply to officers on indent and for sale to the public. The Director is also requested to forward 25 copies of the Notification each to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Bombay and the Divisional Commissioners, Ahmedabad, Poona, Bombay, Rajkot, Nagpur and Aurangabad as soon as the notification is printed.

4. The cost of printing the notification should be debited to the budget head "57-Miscellaneous" for the purpose of *pro forma* accounts.
