C I R C U L A R

Under Section 133 of the Bombay Village.Panchayats Act 1958, as amended by Mah. xxxiv of 1970, it has been provided that the District Village Development Fund shall be utilised for meeting the expenditure on staff ongaged for operating the fund and on all charges incidental thereto such as, printing, stationery, and the like with the sanction of the Divisional Commissioner. A point has been raised as to the criteria that should be followed by the Commissioners before giving sanction to the appointment of the staff. Government has considered this question and has decided that for the work of handling matters relating to and maintaining the accounts of the fund, one Senior Assistant would be sufficient and the Commissioners should sanction one post of Senior Assistant for the work in question in each of the Zilla Parishads. In the districts where the number of village Panchayats is small and there may be no adequate work for the Senior Assistants, he may also be ontrusted with the work of watching the recoveries of population contribution for the Rural Water Supply Schemes. As the Maharashtra Act No.xxxiv of 1970 came into force on 1 st January 1971, expenditure incurred by the Chief Executive Officers prior to that date cannot be debited to the District Village Development Fund.
