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Government servants working during leave periods - The need to avoid such a situation -

CIRCULAR OF GOVERNMENT

It has been brought to the notice of Government that an officer who was granted leave was required to work intermittently unofficially during his leave. Government considers that such an arrangement where an officer is granted leave but during the leave period, he works unofficially, is not proper. If it is considered necessary that an officer who has been granted leave should be on duty to perform any particular functions, proper course would be to cancel his leave and recall him to duty. Confusion is also likely to arise regarding drawal of allowances of a Government servant who is required to work during his leave. All departments of the Secretariat and all Heads of Departments/Offices under their administrative control are, therefore, instructed not to resort to an arrangement where a Government servant is required to work during his leave.

2. The departments of the Secretariat are requested to bring these instructions to the notice of the Boards, Corporations etc.
