CIRCULAR OF GOVERNMENT

In Government Circulars, General Administration Department, No.BCC-1076/1599/685/XVI, dated the 3rd March 1977, 16th April 1977 and 25th July 1977 instructions were issued to the effect that Backward Class Government servants may represent their grievances to the Minister (Social Welfare) or Minister (Tribal Welfare) or Minister of State (Social Welfare) who may obtain the views of the Department concerned in the matter and informally offer their advice to the Minister or Minister of State of the Department concerned and that the responsibility for the decision in the matter would rest with the Minister in charge of that Department. At the time of issue of the aforesaid circulars the then Minister of State for Social Welfare was also holding the portfolios of Tribal Welfare.

2. The portfolios of Social Welfare and Tribal Welfare are at times with one and the same Minister at Cabinet Minister's level or at the level of Minister of State; while at times they are held by different Ministers at either or both levels.

3. Therefore, in partial modification of the orders issued in Government Circulars referred to above, Government is now pleased to direct that Government servants belonging to the Backward Classes who may have a grievance may represent to the Cabinet Ministers and Ministers of State holding any one or both of these portfolios and in such cases the same procedure as laid in the Government Circulars referred to above should be followed.
