CIRCULAR OF GOVERNMENT.

Cases have come to the notice of Government in which Magistrates granted certificates to candidates belonging to Backward Class without specifying clearly the name of the community to which they belonged. Government is therefore pleased to direct that all Magistrates authorised to grant such certificates should clearly specify the actual community to which the candidate concerned belongs. The Magistrates are also requested to see that while issuing certificates they invariably refer to the list of Backward Class Communities as sanctioned by Government and indicate in the certificate correctly the name of the community as shown in the list to which the candidate belongs. In case where a candidate claims to belong to a community not mentioned in the list, they may make a reference to the Director of Backward Class Welfare, Poona and obtain his advice before issuing a certificate.
