

Reservation for certain sections
of the Backward Classes at the
stage of promotion.

READ :- (i) Government Resolution, General Administration
Department, No. BCC-1072-J, dated the
23rd May 1974.

(ii) Government Resolution, General Administration
Department, No. SRV-1074-D, dated the
28th January 1975.

RESOLUTION :- According to the orders issued in
Government Resolution, General Administration Department,
No. BCC-1072-J, dated the 23rd May 1974 read with Government
Resolution, General Administration Department, No. SRV-1074-D,
dated the 28th January 1975, reservation has been provided for
(i) Scheduled Castes, (ii) Scheduled Tribes and (iii) Denotified
Tribes and Nomadic Tribes in all promotions upto first promotion
in Class I posts in services in which the element of direct
recruitment, if any, does not exceed 50%. The question of
enlarging the scope of the existing scheme of reservations for
these three sections of Backward Classes in posts filled by
promotion has been under consideration of Government.

2. Government has now decided, in partial modification
of the orders referred to above, that the reservation for the
(i) Scheduled Castes, (ii) Scheduled Tribes and (iii) Denotified
Tribes/Nomadic Tribes in promotions upto first promotion to
Class I posts should be made applicable to cadres or services in
which the element of direct recruitment, if any, does not exceed
 $66 \frac{2}{3} \%$ instead of 50% as at present.

3. These orders should take effect from the date of issue
except where a Select List for promotion has already been pre-
pared by the Departmental Promotion Committee in accordance with
the Government Resolution, dated the 23rd May, 1974 and approved
by the appropriate authority, before the date of issue of these
orders. In cases where the Select Lists have already been
prepared and approved by the appropriate authority as stated
above, these orders should apply to the preparation of the
subsequent select lists.
