RESOLUTION:- According to the existing orders, 7 per cent of vacancies occurring in each of the various services under Government which are filled by direct recruitment are reserved for members belonging to the Scheduled Tribes including those living outside the specified areas. It was represented to Government that the population of Scheduled Tribes in certain Districts is large, and therefore, the present percentage of reservation for Scheduled Tribes should be increased in such Districts on the basis of the actual percentage of population of the Scheduled Tribes to the Total population of the District. The Legislature Committee on the Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes has also observed in its recent report that the population of Scheduled Tribes is dense in some parts of the State, and that for giving them proper representation a larger number of reserved posts should be made available for recruitment of Scheduled Tribes candidates in such areas.

2. Government has, therefore, carefully considered this question and is now pleased to direct that pending the overall review of the question of reservations for various sections of Backward Classes according to the population figures of 1971 Census, the reservation for Scheduled Tribes in vacancies which are filled by direct recruitment, in respect of Districtwise cadres in Class III and Class IV services, should be increased in the following Districts as shown below :-

Thana	--	22 per cent
Nasik	--	22 per cent
Dhulia	--	22 per cent
Kolaba	--	9 per cent
Yeotmal	--	14 per cent
Chandrapur	--	15 per cent

The reservation for other sections of Backward Classes in the above mentioned Districts should remain the same as at present viz. Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism (13 per cent), Denotified Tribes and Nomadic Tribes (4 per cent), and other Backward Communities (10 per cent).

3. These orders should take effect from the date of issue. The appointing authorities concerned should take particular care to see that these orders are followed scrupulously.
