R E S O L U T I O N

In order to simplify the procedure for payment of leave salary on account of surrender of earned leave or leave on average pay, Government is pleased to modify the conditions(vii) and (viii) of para 2 of Government Resolution, Finance Department No. LVE 2470/634/70-X, dated the 15th May, 1970, as under :-

- "(vii) For determining the amount of leave salary and allowances payable for leave surrendered, a month should be reckoned as 30 days irrespective of the month in which the leave is availed of.
- (viii) The amount of leave salary and allowances for the period of surrendered leave may be paid in advance but not earlier than six days before the commencement of leave. The leave sanctioning authority should certify in the sanctioning order itself to the effect that the earned leave for not less than 30 days will actually be availed of by the Government servant and the same will not be cancelled.

The leave salary for the period of surrendered leave is not liable to deductions on account of Provident Fund Subscriptions, house rent and payment of any advances, etc., to Government and repayment of any dues to Co-operative Societies, etc."
