Resolution:—In supersession of all previous orders on the subject, Government is pleased to lay down the accompanying rules* for the conduct of Government servants in relation to cooperative societies.

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Accompaniment to Government Resolution, Reconstruction Department, No. 5977 dt. the 23rd January 1945.

Rules for the conduct of Government servants in relation to cooperative societies.

1. A Government servant employed under the Cooperative Department may become a member of a consumers' Co-operative society or a co-operative housing Society and may, subject to the general or special orders of the Registrar, invest or deposit money in such a society.

2. Except as provided in rule 1 above, no Government servant employed under the Cooperative Department, with the exception of peons, shall deposit, or invest funds in or lend money to any registered cooperative society or take a loan from such a society on behalf either of himself or any member of his family, or stand surety for any person borrowing from such a society, without the previous sanction of the Registrar in writing.

Note:—The powers of the Registrar under this rule may be exercised by the Deputy Registrar, Asstt. Registrars and Special Auditors in respect of members of the staff working under them.

3. A Government servant employed in any department other than the Cooperative Department may become a member of a cooperative society organised for Government servants only, or of a society organised for Government servants and employees of Local Boards and Municipalities, and may invest or deposit in or take loans from such a society.

4. Any Government servant employed in a Department other than the Cooperative Department may hold shares in any society and may make deposits in any society provided that no Government servant of gazetted rank shall hold shares in any society, other than a society classed as a Bank.

5. Notwithstanding the provisions of rule 4, any Government servant other than a Government servant employed in the Cooperative Department may become a member of, hold shares in, and have dealings with any Consumers' Society, provided that no Government servant shall hold shares of a face value exceeding Rs. 500/- in any such society. Any Government servant may, further, become member of, hold shares of and make deposits in, a Co-operative Housing Society and occupy houses belonging to such a society, subject in the case of gazetted, officers of the Revenue and Public Works Departments serving within the area in which such society is situated to their first obtaining the permission of Government or of such Head of Department as may be specially empowered by Government in this behalf. (21)

6. Except as provided in rule 3 no Government servant shall take a loan from any cooperative society unless he has first obtained the sanction of Government or of such Head of Department as may have been empowered by Government in this behalf. Applications for permission to take a loan under this rule should be accompanied by a full statement of the reasons why the loan is required, the amount of the loan, the rate of interest, and the number and the amount of instalments in which the loan is proposed to be repaid.

7. No Government servant of gazetted rank shall take part in the management of any cooperative society other than,

- (a) a consumers' Society;
- (b) a Society falling under the provisions of rule 3;
- (c) a housing society.

8. No Government servant, who not being a native of India is a member of the Indian Civil Service or is a Commissioned Officer in any of the Defence Services, or holds an office ordinarily held by members of the Indian Civil Service or by Commissioned Officers of the Defence Services, shall make any investment or make deposits in any cooperative society within the Province in which he is employed or within any Province with the administration of which he is concerned, whether such employment is permanent or temporary.

9. Nothing in these rules shall be deemed to prevent a Government servant including gazetted officers and officers of the Cooperative Department from becoming members of and taking part in the management of cooperative societies the objects of which are educational.

10. Government may by general or special order empower the Heads of Departments to exempt any Government servant or class of Government servants under them from any of the provisions of these rules, or may direct that such provisions shall apply to such Government servant or class of Government servants with such modifications as may be specified in the order.
