C I R C U L A R

It has come to the notice of Government that executive posts or posts in the direct line or duty in different Departments are not given to the members of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other members of the minority communities like Muslims and Christians. It is also observed that such persons are posted on side posts carrying equal Pay and statutes. for instance, instead of posting as Deputy Collector and Tahsildars, such officers are posted as Land Acquisition Officers, Leave Reserve Deputy Collectors or Recovery Officers. This is not a happy state of affairs as such officers do not get experience of administrative posts. It also creates a feeling of frustration in such officers, especially when their Juniors hold posts in the direct line. Government desires that all Heads of Departments should make it a point to

see that officers in Government service belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other minority communities get their due share in executive postings in order not only to enable them to gain experience of the post but also to remove any misgivings in the mind of the officers.
