CIRCULAR

In Government Circular Memorandum No. SRV 1160/65330-F, dated 14th December, 1960 information was called for from the Collectors with a view to consider whether it is necessary and feasible to issue any general orders for regularising the wrongful discharges of persons under Revenue Department. On considering the pros and cons of the problem it is found that it is first necessary to establish the fact whether the discharge was or was not wrongful. This is also to be examined with reference to the requirements of the registration with the Employment Exchange; enlistment as candidate for revenue clerks post before the age of 23 years, actual appointment to a temporary or regular post and the nature of Vacancy, the facts whether a person was discharged in preference to his juniors and whether he could have been continued in the post in which his next junior was continued, whether or not he was an ex-Civil Supplies Department person in temporary post in Civil Supplies Department and if so whether he was shown in regular gradation list and why; the circumstances which led to the wrongful discharge and who is responsible for it.

2. The heads of Offices should therefore, examine each case individually with reference to the requirements mentioned in para 1 above and then, if they are convinced that any particular case is of a wrongful discharge and deserves consideration for regularising the irregularity, submit it Government with detailed justification and relevant case papers and service book etc.
