CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. EST. 1079/5180/(1585)/37.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Assistant Hydrologist (Class II), Assistant Engineer (Mechanical) (Class II), Assistant Engineer (Civil) (Class II) and Assistant Chemist (Class II) in the Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Assistant Hydrologist (Class II), Assistant Engineer (Mechanical) (Class II), Assistant Engineer (Civil) (Class II) and Assistant Chemist (Class II) (in the Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency) (Recruitment) Rules, 1982.

2. In these rules unless the context requires otherwise,

- (a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;
- (b) "degree" means a degree of a statutory University;
- (c) "Director" means the Director of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency, Maharashtra State;
- (d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;
- (e) "recognised institution" means an institution recognised by Government.

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3. Appointment to the post of Assistant Hydrologist (Class II) shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person from amongst,

(i) the persons, holding the post of Hydrological Assistant in the Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency and possessing degree or diploma in Civil Engineering and, having not less than 5 years' service in case of degree holders and not less than 8 years' service in case of diploma holders in that post; or

(ii) the persons holding the post of Geological Assistant in the Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency, possessing experience in the Hydrological field work for 5 years in the case of degree holders and for 8 years in the case of diploma holders if no candidate from the cadre of Hydrological Assistant is available; or

(b) by transfer on deputation of a suitable person, already in Government service in other department and possessing degree or diploma in Civil Engineering and having not less than 5 years' experience in case of degree holders and not less than 8 years' experience in case of diploma holders; or

(c) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 35 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree or diploma in Civil Engineering of a statutory University or recognised institution respectively or any other qualification declared by Government to be equivalent thereto; and

(iii) possess experience in Hydrological data analysis work for a period of not less than 3 years in case of degree holders and not less than 5 years in case of diploma holders gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of clause (a) of this rule;

Provided that the age limit or period of experience may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications of experience or both.

4. Appointment to the post of Assistant Engineer (Mechanical) (Class II) shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person from amongst the persons, holding the post of Mechanical Supervisor in the Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency and possessing degree or diploma in Mechanical Engineering and having not less than 5 years' service in case of degree holders and not less than 8 years' service in case of diploma holders; or

(b) by transfer on deputation of a suitable person already in Government service in other department and possessing degree or diploma in Mechanical Engineering and having not less than 5 years' experience in case of degree holders and not less than 8 years' experience in case of diploma holders; or

(c) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 30 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree or diploma in Mechanical Engineering of a statutory University or recognised institution respectively or any other qualification declared by Government to be equivalent thereto; and

(iii) possess experience in Mechanical Engineering for a period of not less than 3 years in case of degree holders and not less than 5 years in case of diploma holders gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of clause (c) of this rule:

Provided that the age limit or period of experience may be relaxed by Government, on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications of experience or both.

5. Appointment to the post of Assistant Engineer (Civil) (Class II) shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person from amongst the person, holding the post of Hydrological Assistant possessing degree or diploma in Civil Engineering and, having not less than 5 years' service in the case of degree holders and, not less than 8 years' service in case of diploma holders in that post; or

(b) by transfer on deputation of a person already in Government service in other department possessing degree or diploma in Civil Engineering and having not less than 5 years' experience in case of degree holders and not less than 8 years' experience in case of diploma holders; or

(c) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 30 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree or diploma in Civil Engineering of a statutory university or recognised institution respectively or any other qualification declared by Government to be equivalent thereto; and

(iii) possess experience for a period of not less than 3 years in case of degree holders and not less than 5 years in case of diploma holders gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of clause (c) of this rule:

Provided that the age limit or period of experience may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both:

Provided further that preference may be given to candidates having aptitude for research works.

6. Appointment to the post of Assistant Chemist (Class II) shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person from amongst the persons, holding the post of Senior Technical Assistant in the Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency and having not less than 3 years' service as Senior Technical Assistant; or

(b) by transfer on deputation of a person already in Government Service

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in other Department and possessing Master's degree of a Statutory University in Chemistry or equivalent qualification and having minimum experience of 3 years in chemical analysis work; or

(c) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 35 years of age;

(ii) possess a Master's degree of a statutory University in Chemistry or any other qualification declared by Government to be equivalent thereto; and

(iii) possess practical experience in Chemical Analysis works for a period of not less than 3 years gained after acquiring qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of clause (c) of this rule;

Provided that the age limit or period of experience may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both;

Provided further that preference may be given to candidates who have aptitude for research work and have published outstanding research papers in the field.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (iii) of clause (c) of rules 3, 4, 5 and 6, if at any stage of selection, the Commission is of the opinion that sufficient numbers of candidates possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes or Nomadic Tribes, then the Commission may, in the matter of such selection, relax the requirement of experience upto one year for degree holders and upto two years for diploma holders relating to rules 3, 4 and 5 and upto one year's experience of work relating to rule 6, and select suitable candidates belonging to such Castes or Tribes.

8. Appointments to the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4, 5 and 6 by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50 : 50.

9. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4, 5 and 6 by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

10. A person appointed to the post mentioned in rules 3, 4, 5 and 6 whether by promotion or nomination, shall be required to pass the Departmental Examinations and examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing those examinations.

11. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India or a post connected with the Defence of India, anywhere in or outside India for a period of not less than four years (inclusive of the period spent in training, if any) on such conditions as may be determined from time to time by the Government of India;

Provided that such persons shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment and ordinarily after he had attained the age of forty years.

12. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

13. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, if in the opinion of Government the exigencies of service so require, Government may, after consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointments to the posts of Assistant Hydrologist (Class II), Assistant Engineer (Mechanical) (Class II), Assistant Engineer (Civil) (Class II) and Assistant Chemist (Class II) in relaxation of the percentage prescribed in these rules for recruitment by nomination.
