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CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. AAPANA. 2089/PK-2048/37.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the posts of Office Superintendent, Senior Clerk, Storekeeper and Store Clerk, Class III in the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency under the Rural Development Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Office Superintendent, Senior Clerk, Storekeeper and Store Clerk, Class III, in the Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency (Recruitment) Rules, 1992.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) "Class IV Service" means Class IV Service as defined under the Maharashtra Civil Services (General Conditions of Service) Rules, 1981;

(b) "Degree" means a degree of a statutory University;

(c) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency, Maharashtra State;

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(d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

(e) "Government Commercial Certificate" means a certificate in typewriting awarded by the Bureau of Government Examinations, Directorate of Education of the Government, and includes a certificate issued by any other institution as may be specifically declared by Government to be equivalent thereto;

(f) "Secondary School Certificate Examination" means the final examination conducted at the end of Secondary Stage of Education by a Divisional Board on behalf of the State Board under the Maharashtra Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards Act, 1965 (Mah. XLI of 1965), and includes any other examination declared by Government to be equivalent thereto.

3. Appointment to the post of Office Superintendent in the Directorate shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the posts of Senior Clerk, Storekeeper or Cashier in the Directorate having regular service of not less than three years in that post; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than twenty-eight years of age; and

(ii) possess a degree in any faculty; and

(iii) possess practical experience in Establishment matters in Government Department for a period of not less than one year, gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii).

4. Appointment to the post of Senior Clerk in the Directorate shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the posts of Clerks or Clerk-cum-Typist or Store Clerk in the Directorate having regular service of not less than three years in that post; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless, already in the service of Government, are not more than twenty-eight years of age; and

(ii) possess Degree in any faculty.

5. Appointment to the post of Storekeeper in the Directorate shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the posts of Clerk or Clerk-cum-Typist or Store Clerk in the Directorate having regular service of not less than three years in that post; or

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(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than twenty-eight years of age ;

(ii) possess Degree in any faculty.

6. Appointment to the post of Store Clerk in the Directorate shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person in Class IV Service, who has put in not less than three years regular service and possesses the educational qualification prescribed for appointment by nomination for the post of Clerk or Clerk-cum-Typist in the Directorate in clause (b) of this rule ; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) are not less than eighteen years and not more than twenty-eight years of age ; and

(ii) have passed the Secondary School Certificate Examination ; and

(iii) possesses a Government Commercial Certificate for a speed of not less than 40 words per minute in English typewriting or 30 words per minute in Marathi Typewriting :

Provided that, the number of vacancies in the cadre to be filled by promotion of Class IV persons shall not exceed 25 per cent of the total vacancies occurring in a particular year.

7. Appointment to any of the post mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 75:25:

Provided that, if in the opinion of Government, the exigencies of service so required, Government may, after consultation with selection authority, wherever necessary make appointment to the post in relaxation of the percentage prescribed under this rule, for recruitment by promotion or nomination.

8. A person appointed to the post mentioned in rule 3 shall be liable for transfer any where in the State of Maharashtra.

9. A person appointed to any of the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4, 5 and 6 whether by promotion or by nomination, shall be required to pass the Departmental Examination, wherever prescribed, in addition to the Examination in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless they have already passed or have been exempted from passing those examinations.
