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CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. RTR. 1080/50/XII.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules, regulating recruitment to the post of Telephone Operator, Class-III, in the offices of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Telephone Operator in the offices of the Government of Maharashtra (Recruitment) Rules, 1985.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—

(a) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

(b) "Secondary School Certificate Examination" means the Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by a Divisional Board under the Maharashtra Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards Act, 1965 (Maharashtra XLI of 1965), and includes any other examination declared by Government to be equivalent thereto.

3. Appointment to the post of Telephone Operator shall be made by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than 28 years of age;

(ii) have passed the Secondary School Certificate Examination; and

(iii) have knowledge of Marathi, English and Hindi, with a fluency in speaking;

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Provided that preference may be given to a candidate possessing training and experience in Telephone Operating :

Provided further that, preference may be given to a candidate who, in the opinion of the Selecting Authority, possesses pleasing manners and agreeable voice :

Provided also that the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Selecting Authority in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

4. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass the examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing, these examinations.
