CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. EST. 1284/465/CR-165/37.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the posts of Hydrological Assistant, Class III and Laboratory Assistant Class III in the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency under the Rural Development Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Hydrological Assistant and Laboratory Assistant in the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency (Recruitment) Rules, 1986.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

- (a) "Degree" means a degree of a Statutory University ;
- (b) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency of the Government of Maharashtra ;
- (c) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra ;
- (d) "Secondary School Certificate Examination" means the Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by a Divisional Board under Maharashtra Secondary Education Board Act, 1965 (Mah. XLI of 1965) and includes any other examination declared by Government to be equivalent thereto.

3. Appointment to the post of Hydrological Assistant in the Directorate shall be made by nomination from amongst candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than thirty years of age :

(ii) possess a degree or Diploma of an institution recognised by Government in Civil Engineering or post Graduate degree in Geology or Applied Geology :

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the appointing authority in favour of candidates who possess exceptional qualifications or experience or both :

Provided further that, the preference may be given to those who have previous experience in a responsible capacity in any institution doing field work in hydrology or hydrogeology and hydrometeorology.

4. Appointment to the post of Laboratory Assistant in the Directorate shall be made by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 28 years of age :

(ii) have passed the S. S. C. Examination :

Provided that preference may be given to candidates having practical experience in a Chemical Analysis Laboratory.

5. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3 and 4 shall be required to pass the departmental examination and examinations in Hindi and Marathi in accordance with the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing such examinations.

6. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer any where in the State of Maharashtra.
