CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. RTR. 1382/188296/(34)/ADM-1.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the posts of **Draftsman, Assistant Draftsman and Tracer (Class-III)** in the Directorate of Geology and Mining of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the **Draftsman, Assistant Draftsman and Tracer (Class-III) in the Directorate of Geology and Mining (Recruitment) Rules, 1986.**

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise ;

(a) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Geology and Mining of the Government of Maharashtra ;

(b) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra ;

(c) "recognised Institution" means an institution recognised by Government ;

(d) "Secondary School Certificate Examination" means the final examination conducted at the end of the secondary stage of education by the Divisional Board established under the Maharashtra Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards Act, 1965 (Mah. XLI of 1965) and includes any other examination declared by Government to be equivalent thereto ;

3. Appointment to the post of **Draftsman in the Directorate** shall be made either—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person, on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the post of Assistant Draftsman in the Directorate ; or

(b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 28 years of age ;

(ii) have passed Secondary School Certificate Examination ;

(iii) possess a certificate in Civil Draftsmanship of a recognised institution or any other qualification declared by Government to be equivalent thereto ; and

(iv) possess practical experience in Civil Draftsmanship for atleast 3 years gained after acquiring qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) and (iii) ;

Provided that, preference may be given to candidates possessing a diploma in Civil Engineering of a recognised institution.

4. Appointment to the post of Assistant Draftsman in the Directorate shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person, on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the post of Tracer in the Directorate; or

(b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 28 years of age;

(ii) have passed Secondary School Certificate Examination;

(iii) possess a certificate in Civil Draftsmanship of a recognised institution or any other qualification declared by Government to be equivalent thereto.

5. Appointment to the post of Tracer in the Directorate shall be made by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(i) unless already in service of Government are not more than 28 years of age;

(ii) have passed Secondary School Certificate Examination; and

(iii) have passed intermediate grade (Drawing) Examination of Government or any other qualification declared by Government to be equivalent thereto;

Provided that preference may be given to candidates possessing a certificate in Civil Draftsmanship of a recognised institution, or any other qualifications declared by Government to be equivalent thereto.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (iv) of clause (b) of rule 3, if at any stage of selection, the Selecting Authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancies are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Castes converts to Buddhism, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes or Nomadic Tribes, then the Selecting Authority may, in the matter of such selection, relax the requirement in respect of the period of experience set out therein, and select suitable candidates belonging to such castes or tribes to fill up such vacancies.

7. Appointment to the post of Draftsman mentioned in rule 3 by promotion and by nomination shall be made in the ratio of 75 : 25 and appointment to the post of Assistant Draftsman mentioned in rule 4 by promotion and by nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50 : 50.

8. A person appointed to the posts by nomination mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 shall be on probation for a period of one year.

9. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or nomination mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 shall be required to pass the examination in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing those examinations.
