RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT

Government is pleased to prescribe the following
recruitment rules for the post of Head Draftsman, Draftsman,
Assistant Draftsman and Tracers in the Public Works Department: -

Head Draftsman

"1. Appointment shall be made either by promotion from
amongst suitably Draftsmen or by nomination from amongst
candidates who -

a) are not more than 25 years of age; and

b) possess a recognised degree in Civil/Mechanical /
Electrical Engineering or a recognised diploma in any of
these branches of Engineering with at least 3 years practical
experience in draftsmanship.

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed in the case of
candidates with outstanding qualifications and/or experience.

2. The candidate selected by nomination shall be on
probation for a period of one year".

Draftsman

"Appointment shall be made either by promotion from
amongst suitable Assistant Draftsman or by nomination from
amongst candidates who -

a) are not more than 25 years of age; and

b) possess a recognised degree or diploma in Civil/
Mechanical/Electrical Engineering".

Assistant Draftsman

"Appointment shall be made either by promotion from
amongst suitable Tracers or by nomination from amongst
candidates who :-

a) are not more than 25 years of age; and

b) have passed the S.S.C. examination or an
recognised examination; and

c) have completed a recognised course of Civil
Draftsman".

Tracers

"Appointment shall be made by nomination from amongst candidates who :-

- a) are not more than 25 years of age;
- b) have a fairly good knowledge of English; and
- c) have passed the intermediate Grade Examination of the Government of Bombay or an equivalent recognised examination.

Provided that preference may be given to candidates who have passed the S.S.C. Examination or an equivalent recognised examination. (modified in Government Regulation, Buildings & Communications Department No. BCS 1355-E(1), dated 26.10.65).

2. The recruitment rules in respect of Head Draftsmen, Draftsmen and Assistant Draftsmen should be applicable to all branches of the Public Works Department, except the Architectural Branch. The recruitment rule for Tracers should, however, be applicable to all the Branches.

3. The Political and Services Department should be requested to incorporate these recruitment rules in the Bombay Civil Services Classification and Recruitment Rules.
