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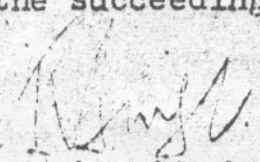

2. The Human Rights Cell under the MHA has also prepared an exhaustive note raising issues regarding alleged violation of human rights by law enforcing agencies. It has been the experience in the past that no magisterial enquiry has been ordered which is a mandatory requirement u/s. 176 of Cr.P.C. It shall be incumbent upon the DMs, SPs and CPs to ensure this particular aspect is given due and prompt attention in each such case. It is also necessary on the part of the investigating agency to put in adequate efforts at the time of prosecution of cases involving custodial deaths to ensure higher percentage of conviction than is presently being achieved. It is requested that the instructions issued by Ministry of Home Affairs may kindly be perused thoroughly and the monthly reports in the prescribed proforma should reach the office of the DGP latest by the 5th of the succeeding month.
